

Belton Preparatory Academy deal summary

On April 21, 2023, the social impact team closed a deal in the Ecofin Sustainable and Social Impact Term Fund. Belton Preparatory Academy is an existing charter school located in Belton, SC that has been operating since 2018 in a temporary location while it seeks its permanent home. Belton Prep offers a classical education curriculum to an underserved population, with great success--as it was recognized as the top academic Title 1 school in the state of South Carolina. The school currently serves approximately 250 students in grades K-6, and will expand to serve K-8 while increasing enrollment over the next 4 years to reach nearly 700 students enrolled. The investment will be used to acquire land, and for construction and equipping of the building. This is the first of three scheduled investments.
